



Fasting and Abstinence Guidelines During Lent

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.



Salt Dough Crown of Thorns

A salt dough crown of thorns can inspire your child(ren) to do penance throughout Lent. Talk to your child(ren) about the crown of thorns that Jesus wore on the day of his death. Explain that we can lighten Jesus's load and pain by making sacrifices throughout Lent. Let your child(ren) remove a thorn each time a sacrifice is made. On Easter, decorate the thornless crown like a royal crown!

Directions:

- 4 c. flour + 1 c. salt + warm water + toothpicks

 combine flour and salt in a big bowl
- add warm water until dough is tacky
- mold dough into 3 strands, braid dough
- use toothpick to create holes in soft dough
 bake in oven @ 350 degrees for 35 min (or until hard and dry)
- remove from oven, allow to cool
- place "thorns" (toothpicks) in crown place crown in a central location in your


